Telford, who now lives in Fairfax, Va., has raised over \$750,000 dollars for research into pediatric cancer and brain tumors through the non- profit Accelerate Brain Cancer Cure. "Though my brain cancer has given me many obstacles to overcome," Telford said, "it has blessed me with the support, love, and friendship of so many. It is so wonderful to be reunited with my friend Sandeep, and to have his and his family's support. I am so thankful."
